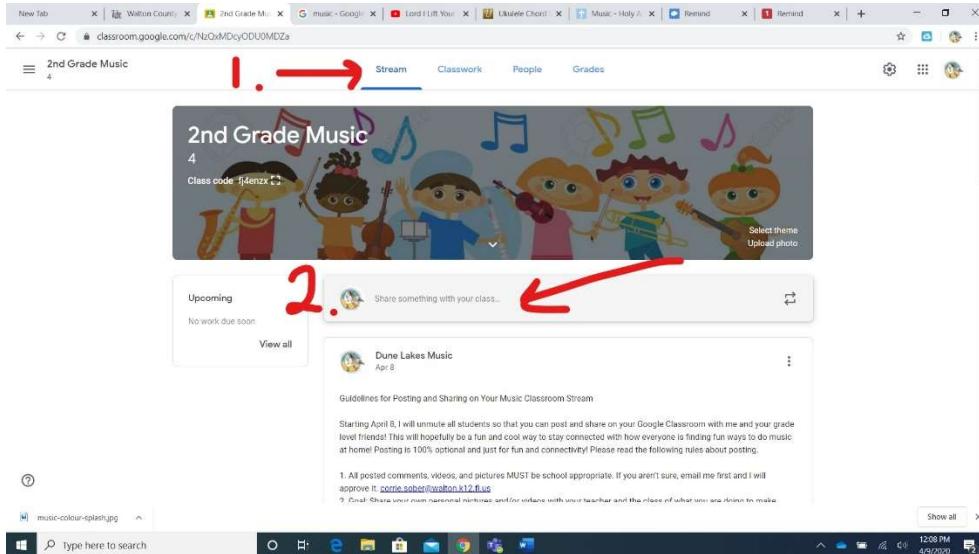
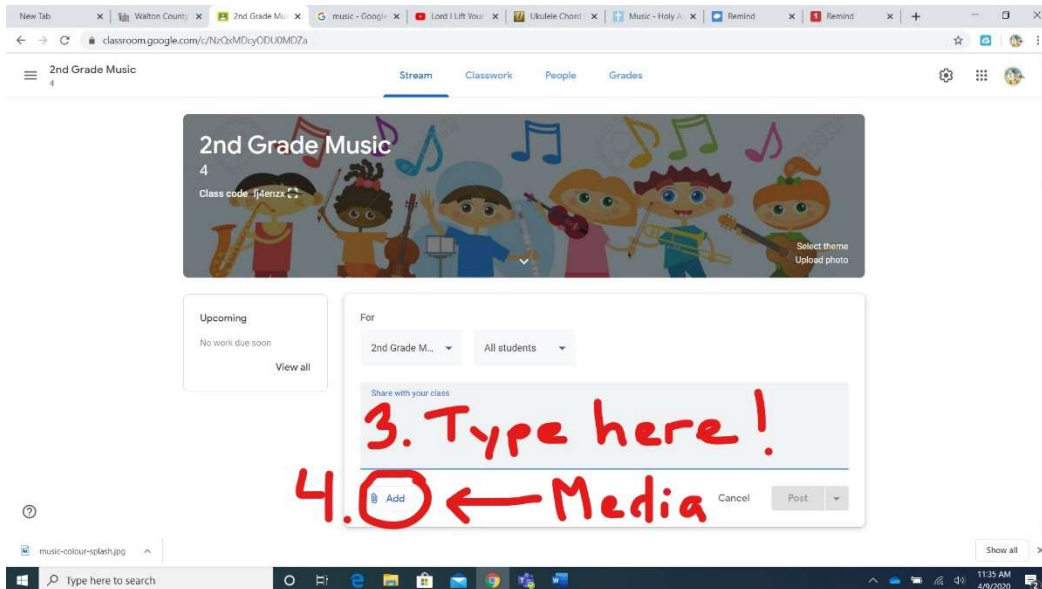


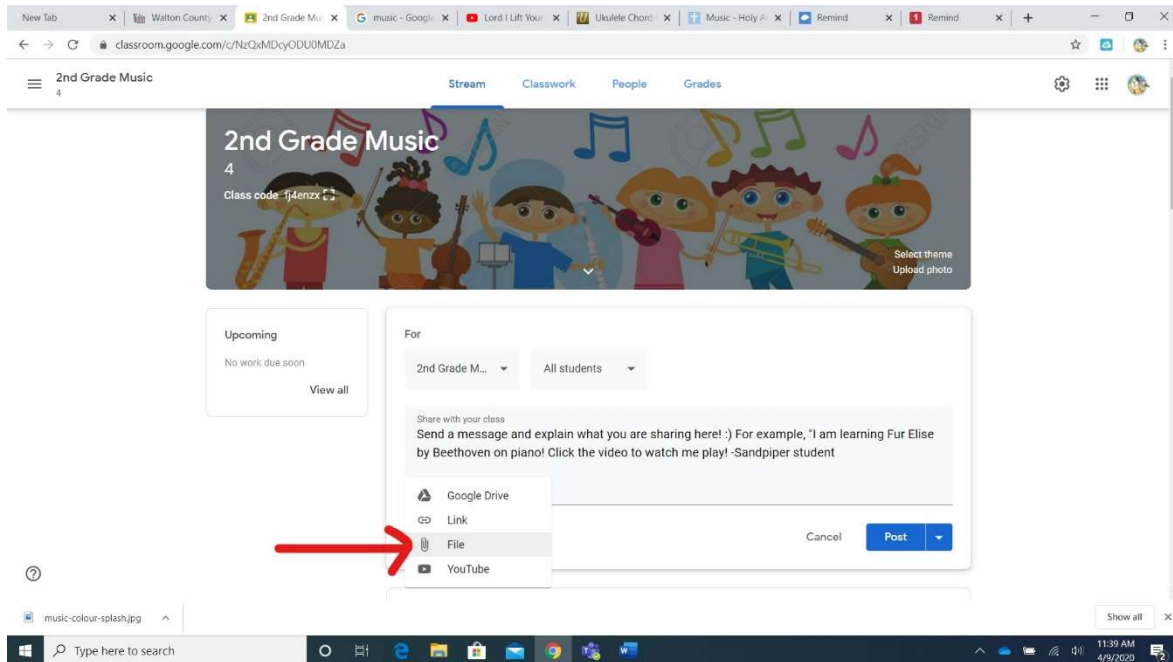
## Posting Your Media on the Stream in Google Classroom

**Step 1-2:** In Google Classroom, click on the **Stream** tab, then click on the posting bar where you see “share something with your class.”

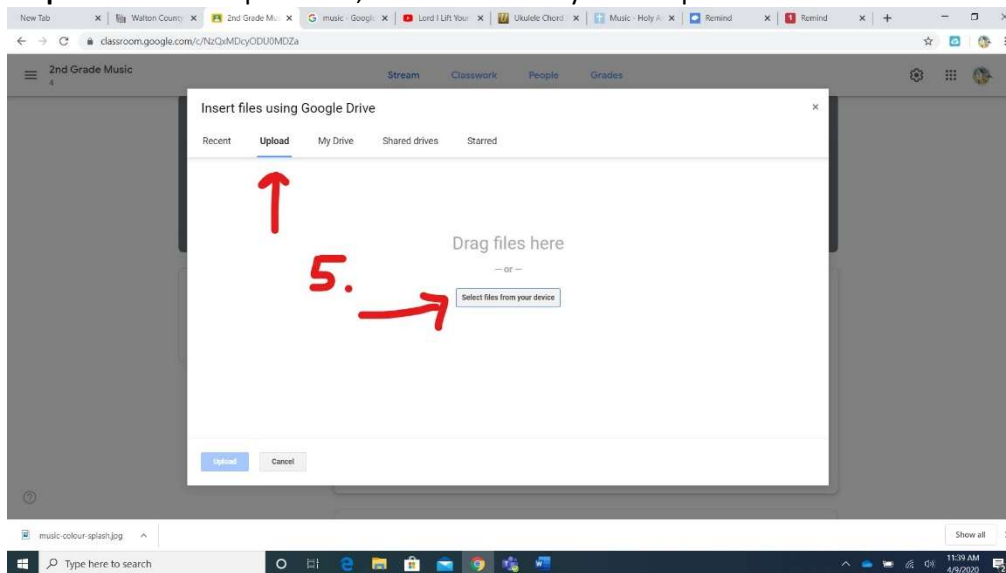


**Step 3-4:** Type about what you are posting in the text box and select the ADD button next to the paperclip to begin uploading media. This tutorial will show you how to upload a file.

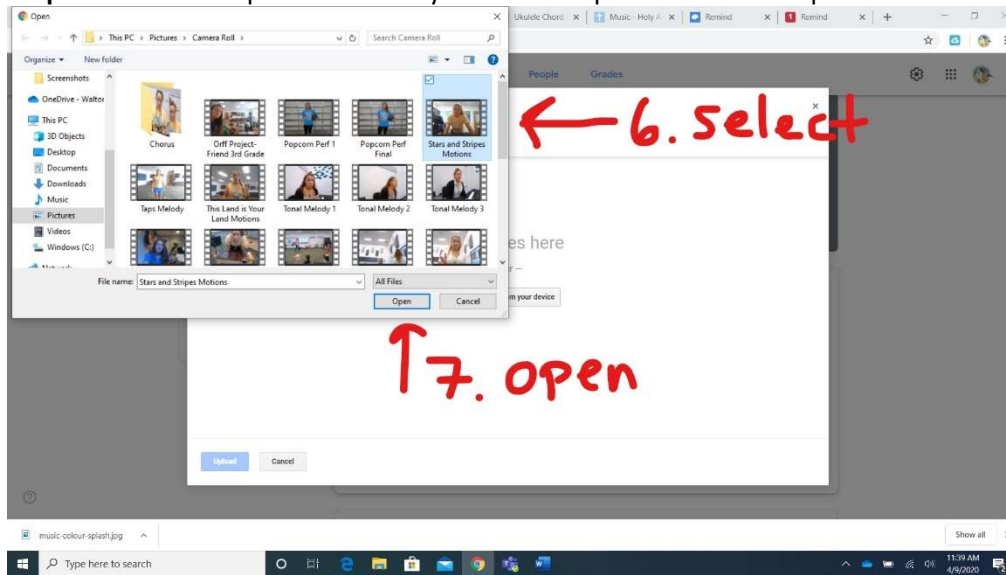




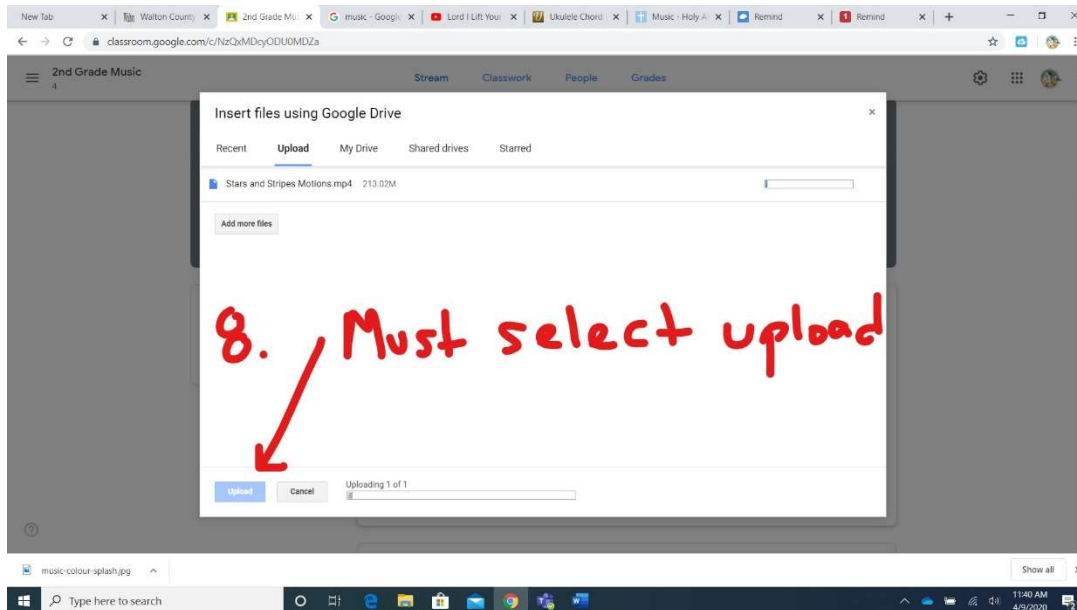
**Step 5:** Under the Upload tab, Select files from your computer.



**Step 6-7:** Select the photo or video you want to upload and select open.



**Step 8:** Your photo/video will show at the top and you must select UPLOAD at the bottom. This will take several minutes depending on the file size and internet speed.



**Step 9: Now your post is ready! Review, select POST, and you are Done!**
